- I4C Program Development: Carol Duane and Matt Grandbois have socialized our Divisional program aimed at removing institutional barriers for underrepresented minorities to pursue careers in chemical management with numerous stakeholders. A pilot proposal has been shared with the Executive Committee for \$10,000 and approved with motion by Mick and seconded by Carol.



- **Technology Commercialization Workshop:** Significant progress has been made in developing scope with several speakers lined up, but timing is still of question so that we can effectively implement this as part of the 2021 BMGT Programming.

- Discussion on BMGT Whalen Award Frequency Our only sole-sponsored Divisional award is offered on a biannual frequency that was established back when we were also financially responsible for a portion of the National ACS Award for Industrial Chemistry, but as I&EC took this over several years ago our financial burden for these awards is not as large as it previous was and may allow us for offering the Whalen award on an annual frequency as a way to build up our Divisional brand and our industrial colleagues involved in chemical management. We do not have a shortage of deserving candidates and if the financial considerations are appropriate.
